DESCRIPTION

The NetRider Client for Macintosh® software allows remote or mobile Macintosh users to communicate over standard telephone lines with another Macintosh or with an AppleTalk® or IP network using the industry standard Point-to-Point (PPP) protocol. With a modem, remote users can dial into one of Digital's remote access servers that support PPP and interact with the network as full peer members, transparently accessing all available network services on both AppleTalk and TCP/IP networks.

The NetRider Client for Macintosh software package can use all of the communication features of the Macintosh, including the Communications Toolbox and the same Connection Control Language (CCL) scripts used in Apple's AppleTalk Remote Access.

The NetRider Client for Macintosh software is integrated with the native AppleTalk protocol stack included with each Macintosh and notifies active connections when the link is closed down. Each NetRider Client for Macintosh kit includes the MacTCP protocol stack as well as common Macintosh utilities.

The NetRider Client for Macintosh software includes the system extensions and application software required to configure, initiate, and manage PPP communications software.

FEATURES

The NetRider Client for Macintosh includes the following features:

- Provides high-speed remote access to AppleTalk and TCP/IP networks.
- Serves remote or mobile users via dial-up telephone lines.
- Provides multi-tiered security, including CHAP and PAP authentication with PPP.

- Fully supports the PPP standard as defined by RFCs 1331, 1332, 1333, and 1378.
- Supports a wide range of network types, including Ethernet.
- Provides an intuitive user interface. Allows editing of modem scripts, which provide a window that allows users to enter login and security information. Connections can be started and stopped at any time using buttons.
- Supports dynamic addressing, allowing the server to assign remote TCP/IP addresses.

APPLICATIONS

Installing NetRider Client for Macintosh and the included utilities install the following applications:

- NetRider Client for Macintosh–Provides point and click remote node connections to AppleTalk and TCP /IP networks.
- MacTCP–Provides the TCP/IP stack needed to communicate with remote TCP/IP resources.
- Anarchie-An Archie and FTP client.
- MacTCP Watcher–Provides diagnostic information about network connections.
- Eudora Light-An SNMP mail client.
- Netscape is also bundled with NetRider for Macintosh.

HARDWARE REQUIREMENTS

To install NetRider Client for Macintosh, the following hardware is required:

- A Macintosh SE or later model
- 4 megabytes of Random Access Memory (RAM)
- A Hayes-compatible modem, 9600 baud minimum, and modem cable

The current version of the NetRider Client for Macintosh software supports Macintosh System 7.1 or higher.

The NetRider Client for Macintosh has been tested with the following processors, though it should run on other Macintosh processors as well:

Modems

The NetRider Client for Macintosh operates with a highspeed, Hayes-compatible modem, 9600 baud minimum.

Disk Space Requirements

To install and operate the NetRider Client for Macintosh software, you need a minimum of 1 MB of disk space on the system disk. This is an approximate number; actual disk space size may vary depending on the user's system environment, configuration, and software options.

SOFTWARE REQUIREMENTS

- Macintosh System 7.1 software or later
- MacTCP® must be installed on your computer. If MacTCP is not already installed NetRider Client for Macintosh installs it automatically. If MacTCP is installed, it is upgraded if necessary.
- On the remote network, support for one or both of the following:
 - DECserver Network Access Software Version 1.3 or later.
 - IP and PPP network addresses provided by the system or administrator.
