



# Remote Office™ Client for NetRider PC Quick Start

This card explains how to install the Remote Office Client for NetRider for the first time on a PC running Windows™. You need the following items to install this product:

- MS-DOS Version 5.0 minimum, Windows Version 3.1 minimum, or Windows for Workgroups Version 3.11 minimum.
- A minimum of 5 MB of free disk space on the system disk.
- One available COM port.
- A Hayes-compatible modem, 9600 baud minimum, and modem cable.
- NetRider installation disks.

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## Begin Installation

### How To Enter Installation Information

During installation, you need to enter information into windows as the procedure progresses.

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• To go to a field in a window, click on the field with your mouse. Or press the <b>Tab</b> key to move from field to field.</li><li>• Sometimes a window has a list from which a selection must be made. To select an item, highlight it by using the cursor keys or by clicking the mouse on the item. Click the scrollbar to see more list items (if necessary).</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• An item in a window containing a <b>highlighted</b> character can be selected by pressing and holding down the <b>Alt</b> key and then pressing the key for the highlighted character.</li><li>• To input the information you have typed into a window and continue, click <b>OK</b> with your mouse or press the <b>Enter</b> key. In the procedure that follows, we assume you are using a mouse.</li></ul> |
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- ☐ 1) Exit Windows (if active).
- ☐ 2) Insert the disk labeled **NetRider Client Installation** in drive A (or B).
- ☐ 3) At the DOS prompt, type **A:INSTALL** (or **B:INSTALL**) and press [Enter].

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## Configure the Software

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Ask your system manager if you have an automated installation procedure. If so, your installation can be different than the one that follows.

- ☐ 1) Enter your **Name** and **Company Name**. Select a destination directory and click **OK**.
- ☐ 2) Select the communication port to which your modem is connected. Check (and, if necessary, modify) the **Irq** and **I/O Addr** settings to make sure they match those for the port you have selected. Click **OK**.
- ☐ 3) Select the modem you are using and click **OK**. If the modem you are using does not appear on the list, select the one that seems most similar to yours and click **OK**.
- ☐ 4) Select NetRider with OnNet TCP/IP or NetRider with OnNet TCP/IP and NetWare as your LAN OS, press the **Tab** key, enter the name of your PC, and click **OK**.
- ☐ 5) Specify your PC's **Internet Address of PC** and the Internet address of your **Domain name server** and click **OK**.
