The Compaq Deskpro EN Series of Personal Computers is positioned as being designed for easy integration within your enterprise. The Deskpro EN Series primarily targets enterprise customers with complex networked environments who value product stability. Due to the complexity of their environments, these customers typically look for platforms that remain stable and consistent over time as well as products that include manageability and serviceability features that simplify deployment and management over the life of the PC.

Platform that Remains Consistent Over Time

Enterprise customers continually stress the importance of minimizing change to the platform in order to manage the effort and expense associated with installing, maintaining, and servicing networked PCs.

Deskpro EN Series products are designed to minimize product change during the lifecycle of the product and enable the purchase of the same PC configuration for a pre-defined period of time. Purchase availability will be clearly defined and communicated for all standard Deskpro EN Series models. The software pre-install, ROM, and driver images will change only to resolve a critical issue; otherwise, updates will be available via the Web. This will give customers the ability to make their own choice: they can either keep the software image, or change if the new technology is important enough to them.

The Deskpro EN Series also participates in the Change Control Program, which includes Change Notification. Change Notification provides proactive, advance communication when product changes become necessary. Changes are communicated as soon as identified, with a goal of 60 days advance notice, to ensure that customers are given adequate time to plan and execute the change. The Deskpro EN Series provide advance, proactive notification of changes with a goal of no software or ROM changes for at least 12 months.

To prevent unauthorized user tampering and reduce service calls, the Small Form Factor and Slim Desktop chassis feature a Smart Cover Lock and Sensor. These software-controlled mechanisms permit automatic lockdown of the hood from any remote administrator console and send alerts to the administrator when the chassis has been opened.
