Managing Exchange 2000 environments is now easier than ever.

The BindView[®] bv-Control[™] for Microsoft[®] Exchange v3.0 software solution offers a host of new features for the Exchange 2000 and Exchange 5.5 computing environments. Messaging system administrators gain enhanced capabilities for performing e-mail policy establishment and enforcement, security assessment, and the preparation and deployment of Exchange 2000 and Active Directory[™]. This solution helps reduce the cost of ownership for Microsoft Exchange Server configurations, including native Exchange 5.5, mixed-mode Exchange 2000, and native Exchange 2000 configurations.

New Features Provide More Benefits:

Support for all Microsoft Exchange 2000 configurations

Version 3.0 of bv-Control for Microsoft Exchange offers a range of features bringing new efficiencies and management capabilities to Exchange administrators running a mixed or native mode Exchange 2000 environment. With this solution administrators can:

- Analyze Exchange 2000 services and server configurations, mailbox, distribution lists, and public folder properties
- Use ActiveAdmin to update Mailbox properties to include those Active Directory properties specific to Exchange 2000
- View and manage mail-enabled user accounts in the GAL browser
- Create customized reports using new Active Directory fields
- Manage Exchange 5.5 and Exchange 2000 servers together

Mailbox moves

System administrators will increase their daily productivity and ease their workload during migrations with increased functionality in managing Exchange mailboxes. They can:

- Drag-and-drop mailboxes between Exchange 5.5 organizations, or between Exchange 5.5 and Exchange 2000 within the same site
- Drag-and-drop mailboxes between separate Exchange 2000 administrative groups
- Schedule a move mailbox task using Windows NT/Windows 2000 tool or Command Line support
- Log all mailbox moves, including the date, time, user, and action performed
- Remove old X.400 addresses during a mailbox move

Extended administrative capabilities

Using the exclusive functionality of bv-Control, administrators can now:

- Release licenses bound to moved objects and re-assign them to the license pool or other objects
- Create and edit distribution lists using drag-and-drop functionality

Enhanced out-of-the-box reporting

Administrators benefit from a variety of new reporting capabilities, pre-packaged with v3.0. They can:

- Query against WMI data to access property information on Exchange 2000 servers
- Use wildcard search criteria as fields and filters when running reports
- Create a single report on Top 10 senders and receivers of e-mail by mailbox
