The Compaq Prosignia NeoServer is the first ready-to-go server from Compaq that puts your small business on the fastest path to success. The Prosignia NeoServer is so easy to own that your hassle-free set-up time can be achieved in an unprecedented amount of time.¹

The Small to Medium Business Market is the fastest growing market in the server space. Small Office Businesses, non-residential businesses with fewer than 10 employees in the total corporation, are growing at 38%, and Small Businesses, establishments with 10 to 99 employees in the total corporation, are growing at 35%.²

Until now, Appliance Servers and PC Servers have comprised two distinct categories of network computing for these businesses:

Appliance Server Category

Appliance Servers are designed primarily for the corporate enterprise customers, although some small and medium businesses may choose to use them as well. An Appliance Server typically provides one specific dedicated function and provides that function very well. They include all the hardware and software needed to provide this functionality; there is no need to add or upgrade. Examples of Appliance Servers include Web Servers, Caching Servers, and Firewall Servers, to name a few. Deploying and using these Appliance Servers may require more technical savvy than some small businesses have. Companies that offer products like these include Network Appliance and Whistle Communications.

PC Server Category

PC Servers are designed for almost any size company but are primarily purchased by corporate and enterprise customers and larger small and medium businesses. PC Servers typically run most general-purpose applications. With these products, the hardware and software are typically sold separately, so that customers have the ultimate in flexibility and can configure them as they require. They are easily upgradeable with new hardware or software as required by the customer. Examples of PC Servers include the Compaq Prosignia 720, the Compaq ProLiant 800, the Dell PowerEdge 1300, and the HP NetServer.

NeoServer: A new category of network computing for more robust functionality

The NeoServer category is a new and emerging category, founded by Compaq. In working closely with small businesses, Compaq identified a particular set of needs and defined this new standard. NeoServers are designed specifically to meet the unique needs of small businesses.
