

Readme for DS-XG NT4.0 Driver ver. 4.00.1228

Because this driver has various functions depending on the device you use, you may need a customization on the driver.

To make a customization, please follow the steps below:

1. If you have already installed a DS-XG driver, please remove "Audio for YAMAHA DS-XG Audio Driver" from Control Panel/Multimedia/Devices/Audio Devices first. Then restart the system.
2. Go into an appropriate directory under ¥Custtool. (There should be ydsxg.exe and ydsxg.cst in the directory.

¥Custtool

¥DS-1E -> For YMF754(DS-1E)

¥2ch -> For generic 2ch system

¥Generic 4ch -> For generic 4ch system with 2 AC97 CODECs

¥STAC9708_1 -> For STAC9708 4ch system which has separate Jack for Rear output.

¥STAC9708_2 -> For STAC9708 4ch system which uses GPIO2 to switch between Line in/Rear output.

¥DS-1S -> For YMF754(DS-1S)

¥2ch -> For generic 2ch system

¥Generic 4ch -> For generic 4ch system with 2 AC97 CODECs

¥STAC9708_1 -> For STAC9708 4ch system which has separate Jack for Rear output.

¥STAC9708_2 -> For STAC9708 4ch system which uses GPIO2 to switch between Line in/Rear output.

3. Execute ydsxg.exe by double-clicking on it from the Windows Explorer.
4. When you see a "Welcome" dialog box, click "Next".
5. You will see a message saying "The Setup program for the DS-XG/WindowsNT Driver is ready to complete." Click "Finish".
6. You will see a message saying "Customizing is success.". Click "OK".
7. Install the driver following the standard procedure.

Note

- (1) Customization can be done after the driver is installed. However, the default values of the mixer controls cannot be customized in this case.
- (2) If you need different customization, please ask your rep or your contact at Yamaha.
